\$913,146 Pledged to Campaign 49 Families Pledge Support This Week

The results of our sixth campaign report are in! Continuing upward progress was made this week with an additional \$61,850 pledged, bringing our total raised to \$913,146, 46% of our goal of \$2.0 million. Current results are:
